<u>Misconception</u>: You can end violence with more violence.

Truth: The only way Europe and the world sees peace is after World War II. They see peace by rebuilding, not looking for revenge.



REVENGE IS NOT ALWAYS GOOD!

You win. You defeat your enemy. You stand over your enemy. You are the champion. Do you humiliate him? Do you punish him? Do you make him pay for every single bad thing he has done to you?

Or do you lose your emotions? Do you separate yourself from your hatred? Do you help your enemy like he's your brother? Do you try to help him back on his feet—give him your trust and love?




These are the questions after World War II.: World War II was the worst war ever. More people die in World War II than any other war. People die in Europe, Asia, and Africa. Everywhere. Millions of people.

Do we punish Germany for Hitler? Do we punish Japan for Hirohito? Do we go the same way as Treaty of Versailles? Are we **punitive** or are we forgiving?

After World War I, France and England made Germany accept punitive conditions. But after World War II, things are different.



One issue is economic. After World War I, Germany had to pay reparations. It destroyed the German economy. Then, it destroyed the world economy and led to the Great Depression.



America has a different plan after World War II. The man who came up with it was George C. **Marshall.** Instead of making West Germany pay, he lent \$\$\$\$\$\$\$\$\$ to West Germany. He gave West Germany tons of money to rebuild. He loaned France money, too. The USA pumped Europe filled with money. And nothing helps heal the wounds of war like money.



So, instead of making Germany pay, they paid West Germany. George Marshall took care of West Germany. The Marshall Plan reinvigorated and revived the European economic system.


All of Europe is divided into two sides after World War II.

All of the World is divided into two sides:



Communism versus Democracy. This is the beginning of the Cold War. The Cold War starts after World War II. The Cold War is the USA versus the USSR.



Everywhere controlled by the USSR becomes Communist and Totalitarian. They become part of the USSR and its group of allies, the Warsaw Pact.



Everywhere controlled by the USA/England becomes democratic and Capitalist. They form a treaty called NATO.

Communist countries have no freedom of speech or religion. They don't have freedom of economics. They have a dictator who controls everything.

They use propaganda to say that they are more equal than anywhere else. But this isn't true.

The leaders of Communist countries are rich.

The workers are poor.

Democratic countries have freedom of speech and religion. They have a free market economy. There are fewer regulations. They have elections, not dictators.

They also use propaganda. But the free market system makes the countries richer, so there is more equality in these countries. Their economic system is capitalism.

The Berlin Wall divides the Democratic World and the Communist World.



West Berlin is controlled by the USA. West Germany is the ally of the USA. They are democratic and capitalist. They grow and grow over time and become strong. The Marshall Plan helps them to rebuild.

East Berlin is controlled by the USSR. East Germany is allies with the USSR. They are Communist and Totalitarian. East Germany becomes very poor because the USSR takes a lot of their money. People want to climb the wall to freedom.



The Marshall Plan saves Western Europe. It gives them money. The USA also gives Western Europe military support. This is called NATO. It is an alliance between all the democracies in Western Europe and the USA.

NATO says that the USA will protect the democracies from the USSR. If the USSR attacks any NATO country, the USA will declare war.

The USA leaves many soldiers in West Berlin to fight the Soviets if they attack.


Japan is different than Europe.


Predict Why do you think Japan is different than Europe?

Europe is always the focus. But what about Japan? Many Americans really hate Japan after World War II. They are very racist towards the Japanese and see them as animals.

Remember: The USA used the Atomic Bomb on Japan, not in Europe.

So, how should the USA treat Japan?





Many people want to be punitive to Japan. But you can't end violence with violence.

The USA gives Japan money. And they give Japan military support. The USA does the same thing in Japan that they do in Europe.

The USA leaves their army in Japan. Japan can't have an army; they are not allowed. But the USA promises to defend them. Then, they give them money.

Douglas MacArthur is in charge of the US forces in Japan. The USA sends Japan money. They also leave soldiers in Japan.

They say: "Japan, you can't have an army because of what you did in World War II. But you don't need an army because we will stay here and protect you."

SO... THE USA JUST BOMBED AND DESTROYED TWO CITIES IN JAPAN. THEY HATE JAPANESE. But they promise to protect them!


Japan uses the money from the USA to make factories. Soon, Japan will be an economic power—not a military power.




But, the real story at the end of World War II is this new Cold War in Europe.


